YPT and Medical Forms: Every adult in camp needs Youth Protection Training, available online at myscouting.org. YPT is good for two years. You and your scout will need BSA medical forms parts A, B, and C. Part C must be signed by a physician for both of you – no substitute physical forms are allowed. Your scout also needs the GNFC over-the-counter drug form filled out with his pediatrician's signature. These files plus instructions are available on our website http://pack4.weebly.com/files.html.
